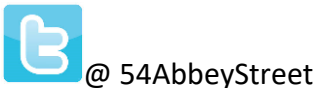

FAIRTRADE FORTNIGHT 2018
26 FEBRUARY – 11 MARCH



Fairtrade Fortnight (26 February - 11 March) is an action-packed highlight of the year, when campaigners, businesses, schools and places of worship show their support for the farmers and workers who grow our food in developing countries. 2018 sees Lancashire's Status as a Fairtrade County in its 3rd Year – this was achieved with the amount of support for Fairtrade throughout the county from Fairtrade supporting boroughs, towns, villages and communities. Hyndburn needs to renew its status as a Fairtrade Borough and we would like to hear from local Schools, Churches, Mosques & Community Groups who would like to do more to support Fairtrade, so that we can come together and run regular monthly stalls to create more awareness in the community.

It is a testament to the demand for Fairtrade that the number of products carrying the Fairtrade Mark has increased over the years, and apart from the Fairtrade tea, coffee, sugar & chocolate we stock, here are some of the many different items we have on our shelves for you to choose from!

The Clean & Fair washing up liquid and hand wash contain Fairtrade coconut oil from India, and fair trade eco-friendly palm oil (known as FairPalm) from Seredipalm in Ghana. They are kind to your skin and just as good for the earth, as they are for your home!



King Soba Organic Fairtrade Brown Rice Pad Thai or Vermicelli Noodles are ideal for vegetarians, vegans, celiacs or those with gluten or wheat sensitivities



This organic coconut oil is an extra virgin oil from Pearls of Samarkand, made from coconuts grown in Sri Lanka. This is Fairtrade coconut oil at its purest - it's organic, extra virgin, 100% natural, unbleached, unhardened, unrefined, totally free of additives, vegan, raw, and processed with love and care!
